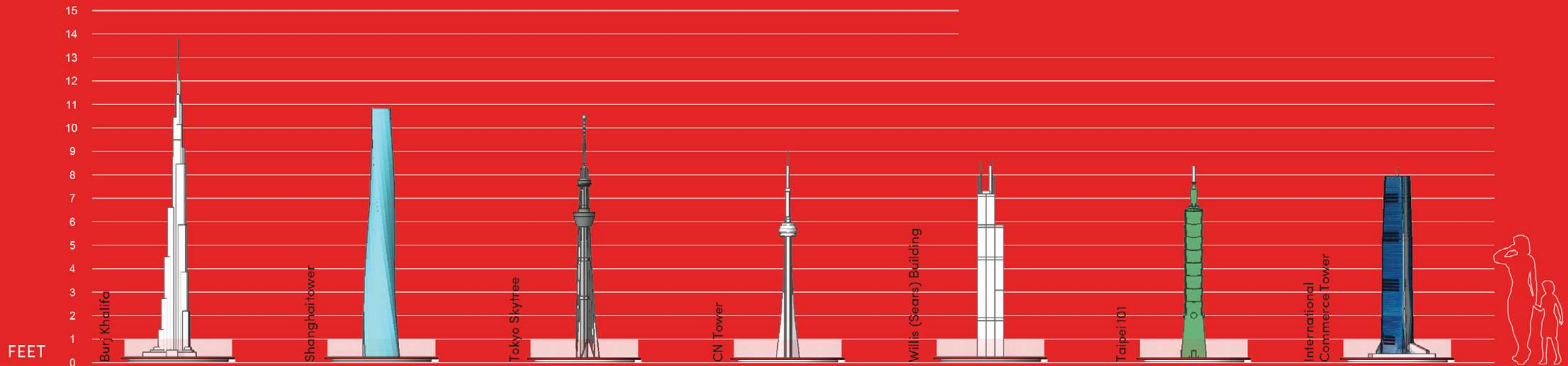

Young and old will be limited only by their imagination as they add their creations to a steadily rising futuristic LEGO metropolis inside the exhibition.
